Junior Queen 9-15 YEARS OLD

Senior Queen 16-19 YEARS OLD (Never been married)

All contestants will be judged on:

Horsemanship:

Control-Ability to maneuver horse properly

Proper Pattern

Stopping and Backing

Balance and Posture

Horse & Rider working together

Interview:

Manners and attitude in and around the competition

Knowledge of basic horse information.

Appearance:

Grooming of Horse

Cleanliness & Safety of Tack

Neatness of Rider

Rider meeting clothing requirements: jeans, long sleeved shirt, hat, boots, and belt

Overall appearance of horse and rider.

This is not a clothing and tack contest. Neat and clean western clothes that fit properly and clean tack is what the judges will be looking for. The objective of this contest is to choose a girl who can ride well, exhibits showmanship and ambition, and represents herself and Izard County in a dignified and honorable manner.
