Dept. 18 – Horses

All horses must be entered online by Saturday, July 15, 2023. If an exhibitor does not have access to a computer, contact your County Extension Office or Vo-Ag Instructor. All breeds may be exhibited.

1. Coggins' test and papers will be checked at the entrance of the fairgrounds. Papers must match horse. Any exhibitor without current Coggins' papers will not be permitted on fairgrounds.

2. Horses must be owned by exhibitor or exhibitor family by July 1, 2023.

3. An exhibitor can show an unlimited number of horses.

a. The same horse can only be shown once per class, unless shown by siblings. Siblings may share a horse, even in the same age division, in the following classes:

1.Trail

2. Barrels

3. Pole Bending

- 4. Flags
- 5. Stakes Race
- 6. Keyhole

b. Horse may only be shared if another suitable horse is not owned by the family for the siblings to ride.

4. No Stallions or Jacks.

5. Miniature Horses are 38" and under. Ponies are 52" and under. Questionable height animals will be measured.

6. Halter Classes will be divided into 5 divisions:

Miniature: Under 38" measured at the wither Pony: Under 52" measured at the wither Stock type: Quarter Horse, Appaloosa Light Breed: Arabian, Saddlebred, Morgan Draft: Belgian, Percheron, Suffolk Punch, Clydesdale, Shire

6. Classes denoted as Junior(JR) and Senior(SR) age pertains to the rider, not the horse.

7. Only authorized persons will be in the ring at time of judging.

8. <u>Proper attire</u>: Long sleeves, pants and a collared shirt must be worn. A hat or helmet is required. Hat or helmet can be worn without judge's discrimination of one over the other. Western-type boots must be worn. No sneakers or "western style" shoes permitted.

9. <u>High Point Awards</u>-Points are tabulated on a one (1) horse and one (1) rider team.

a. Any ties will be broken by the highest number of 1st places, 2nd places, etc. if there is still a tie, the tie breaker class for performance classes will be Trail score. For speed classes the tie breaker class will be pole bending.

Points are awarded as follows: 1st place – 25 pts, 2nd place – 20 pts, 3rd place – 15 pts, 4th place – 10 pts, and 5th place – 5 pts.
